Know the Rules- Ask Questions

New Sanctioning Guidelines (Began July 1, 2019):

- ✓ For **Cross Country, Swim, Volleyball, Track, Wrestling and Golf**: If an entry fee is charged for participation (no matter the number of teams), the event must be sanctioned.
- ✓ For **Cheer, Lacrosse, Tennis, Baseball, Softball, Soccer and Basketball**: If four or more schools are participating, the event must be sanctioned.
- ✓ Brackets are required for **Lacrosse, Tennis, Baseball, Softball, Soccer and Basketball**. For each invitational tournament in all sports, the League will charge a \$50.00 sanctioning fee.

When to use SCHSL form, Border State form, NFHS

- ✓ **SCHSL** - Events in which only South Carolina schools have been invited
- ✓ **Border State** - Events in which schools from North Carolina and/or Georgia have been invited NFHS
- ✓ Any **interstate** or **international** event involving two (2) or more schools which is co-sponsored by or titled in the name of an organization outside the school community (e.g., a college/university, a theme park, a service organization (Kiwanis, Optimist) or an athletic shoe/apparel company)
- ✓ Events in non-bordering states if **five (5) or more** states are involved
- ✓ Events in non-bordering states if **more than eight (8)** schools are involved



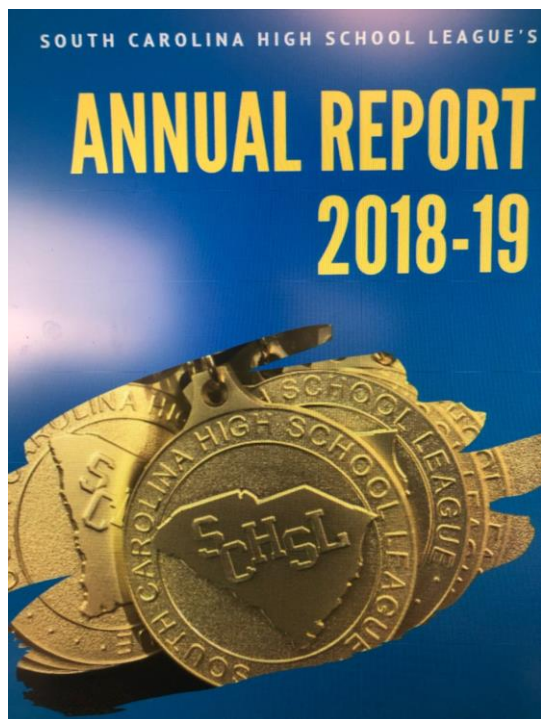
ATTN: FOOTBALL COACHES
