IMPORTANT FOR AAAA COACHES – Please arrive before the start of the AAA races. If you arrive later, you will have to park farther away. Spectator and bus traffic cross the course so access will be limited after the start of the first AAA race.

<u>Timing Chips</u> - Timing will be done by CKET Timing Company. Shoe chips will be provided for each athlete. Chips must be secured to the athletes' shoes using the provided TWIST-TIES. These will be COLLECTED BY THE COACHES AFTER THE RACE AND TURNED INTO THE TIMING TENT BEFORE YOU LEAVE. Please tell your athletes to make sure that they GIVE EACH COACH THEIR CHIPS BEFORE THEY LEAVE. There will be a \$25 charge for each chip that is not returned. EACH SCHOOL WILL BE ISSUED 7 CHIPS. 1 FOR 1 SUBS WILL BE ALLOWED 15 MIN PRIOR TO YOUR RACE! It would be appreciated if the chips could be returned in numerical order.

<u>Number of Runners</u>: The maximum number of runners per school who will be allowed to race will be seven. Only submit seven runners for the State Qualifying Meet. You will be allowed to make exchanges up to 15 minutes before the start of your race using the names that were submitted on your eligibility list provided they have participated in at least two meets during regular season. The form in your packet must be completed. Be sure to enter under the correct meet. <u>If you are a AAAA school, enter the AAAA Upper State Qualifier</u>.

<u>ALERT !!!!!!!</u> Registration for the State Qualifier must be submitted by <u>11:59 Sunday, November 3, 2019</u>. Schools that register any runner(s) after the deadline may be fined \$100. If you have problems registering, contact Ed Boehmke at eboehmke@greenville.k12.sc.us. OR Eric Cummings at ercummin@greenville.k12.sc.us .If you are unable to reach Ed or Eric, email Skip Lax at <u>skip@schsl.org</u>. This is to be done prior to the deadline. <u>Don't wait until the last minute.</u>

<u>Reminder</u>: Coaches should remember that all governing rules apply when it comes to uniforms and conduct. Violation of the rules will result in disqualification. Please review Rule 9, Section 6 & 7 of the NFHS Track & Field and Cross Country Rule Book. Uniforms must BE THE SAME CORE COLOR AND SAME ACCENT COLOR and be school issued for cross country (no football or basketball jerseys or shorts, etc.) Undergarments do not have to match. Only prescription sunglasses, with a doctor's note, may be worn. Headbands are allowed provided the logo is smaller than 2 square inches. However, hats may not be worn.

<u>Results</u> will be posted as soon as possible after the completion of each race. Teams and individuals that qualify will be marked. Check these carefully. Once the meet is complete, these results are official and cannot be changed. The results will also be uploaded to SCRunners.com as soon as possible.

<u>After the Qualifying Meet</u> you MUST go to the online entry page and submit up to 7 entries for each of your teams that qualified or any individuals from your school that qualified. Qualifying does NOT automatically enter you into the State Championships. Entry into the State Meet will be on carolinaxc.com. DO NOT enter the meet until after the qualifying meets. MAKE SURE THAT YOU ENTER THE CORRECT CLASSIFICATION. The entry deadline for the State Championships for ALL CLASSIFICATIONS is 11:59 p.m. Sunday night November 10.
