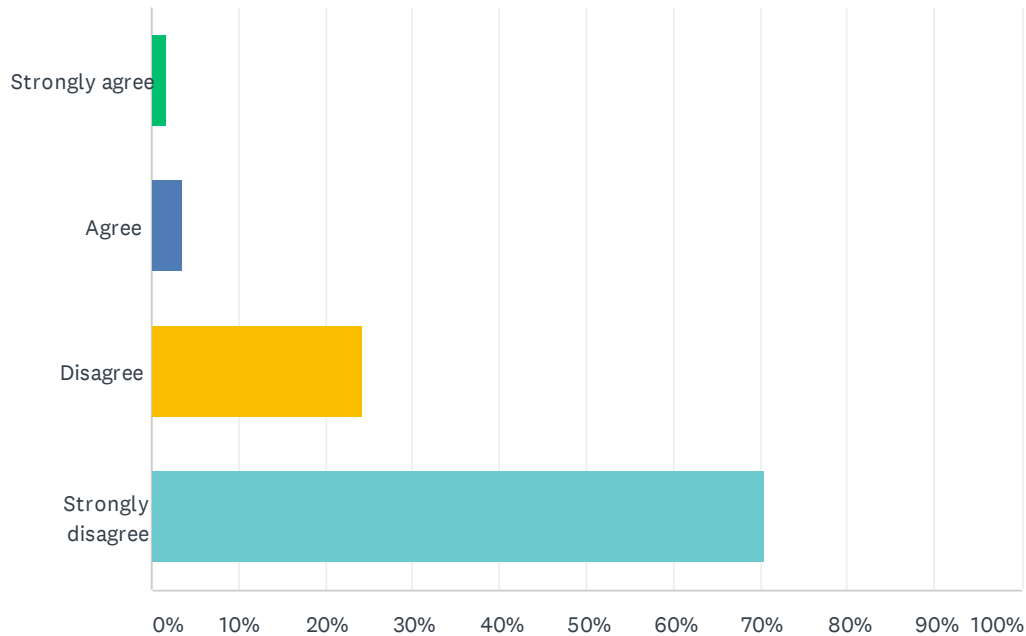

Q12 Did the return to play workouts include?

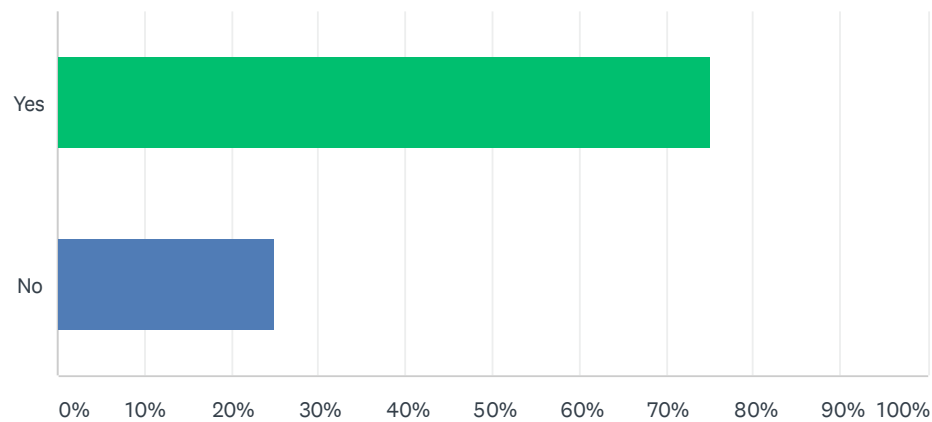

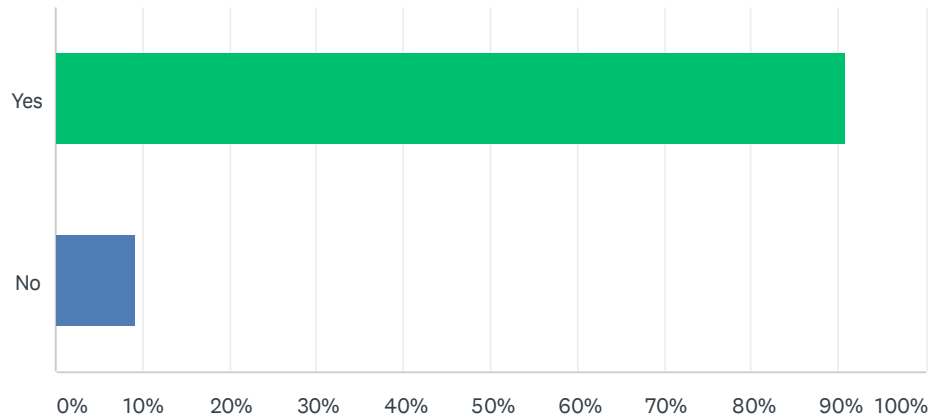
