The League is pleased to sponsor a Scholar Athlete recognition program. The purpose of this program is to identify students in our member schools who qualify as outstanding athletes and at the same time maintain a high academic standard.

All nominees must meet the following standards:

1. Be a senior.
2. Must have lettered in two sports for at least one season or in one sport for at least two seasons.
3. Must have maintained at least a 3.5 GPA for seven semesters.
4. Must have exhibited outstanding citizenship and sportsmanship.
5. Non-Competitive Cheerleaders do not qualify.
6. It is recommended that the student letter as a Senior.

It is important that all forms be submitted to the League Office ASAP.

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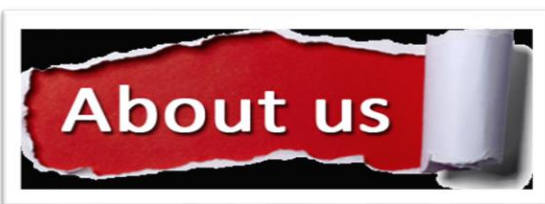
